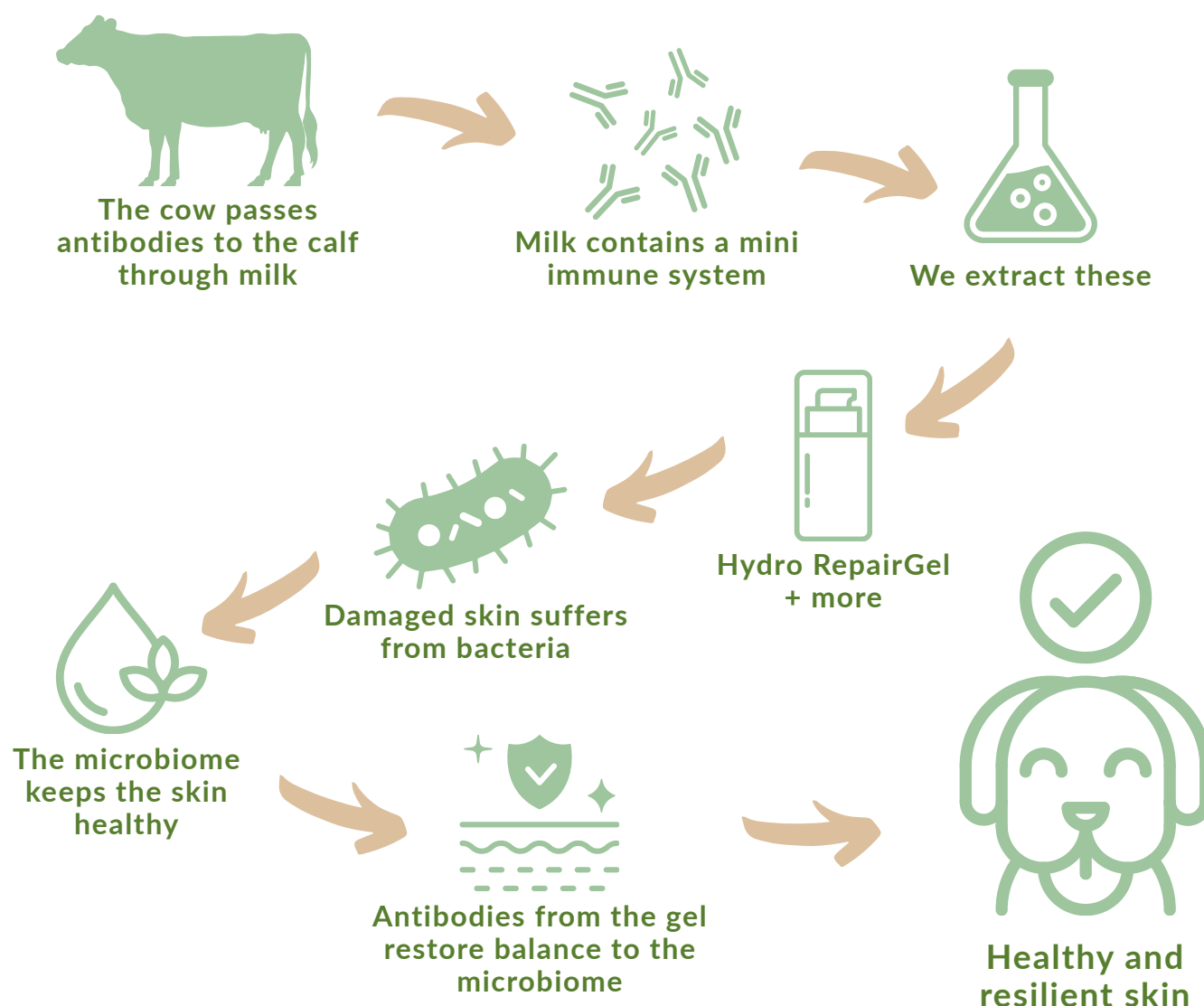


The Science behind Doderm

Our bodies host countless microorganisms such as bacteria, viruses, and yeasts. Together, they form the microbiome. Staphylococcus bacteria – normally part of the skin’s natural flora – can penetrate the skin when the microbiome is disrupted. This results in weakened skin that is more susceptible to bacterial infections. The toxins produced by Staphylococcus then trigger inflammation.

In cows, calves do not receive immune protection through the placenta during pregnancy. Instead, the necessary immune defenses are provided immediately after birth through colostrum (first milk). This first milk is rich in antibodies – a “mini-immune system” – that the cow passes on to her calf. We obtain these antibodies from the milk once the calf has been sufficiently supplied. Using a specialized process, we extract antibodies that specifically target Staphylococcus and incorporate them into our Doderm Hydro RepairGel.

Together with other key ingredients, the gel supports the skin in fighting harmful bacteria, nourishes the natural microbiome, and restores the pH balance. As a result, the skin becomes more resilient – the good bacteria return, and the harmful ones disappear. In addition, our skin gel contains nutrients (“food”) for the beneficial bacteria, helping them thrive immediately.



Doderm Hydro RepairGel Pet

A hydrogel made with 100% natural ingredients, free from synthetic preservatives and artificial fragrances. The gel comes in a practical 50 ml airless pump dispenser, making it easy to dose, economical in use, and protected from air contamination. It can be easily applied to the skin or coat, absorbs quickly, and soothes irritated skin areas. Suitable for the care of skin problems such as redness, itching, dandruff, or eczema. Also ideal as supportive care for chronically irritated skin.



Doderm SOS RepairGel

This gel in a compact 15 ml airless pump dispenser is a quick helper for minor injuries, insect bites, or sunburn. It is also suitable for wound care after surgery.

Ingredients

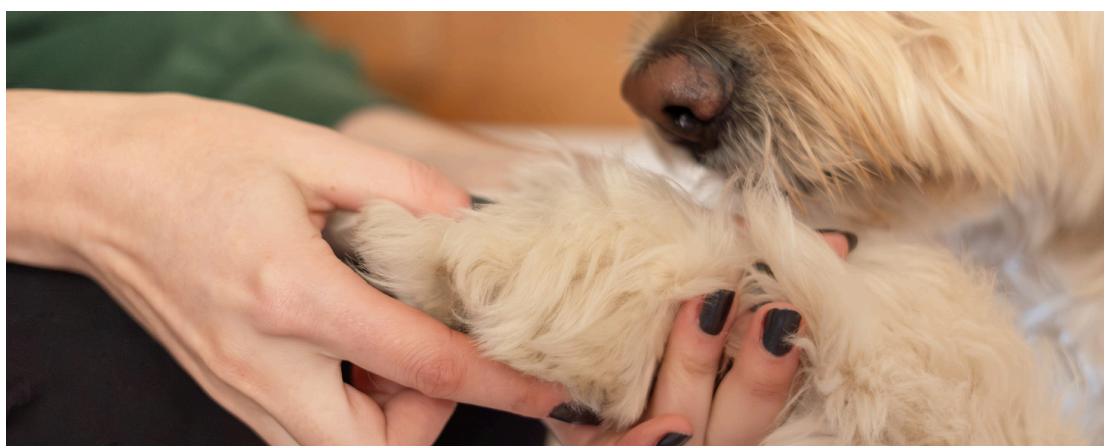
In addition to antibodies from cow's milk, the gel contains other active ingredients that soothe and regenerate the skin:

- **Honey** – effective against fungal growth
- **Ceramides** – strengthen the skin barrier
- **Oats** – relieve itching
- **Balloon vine, witch hazel, and calendula** – support wound healing and calm the skin
- **Vitamins A, E, and B** – promote skin regeneration

All Doderm products are doping-free and safe for pregnant animals.

Application

Start by cleaning the affected skin area with lukewarm water and a mild shampoo, rinsing thoroughly until the water runs clear. Then gently pat dry with a clean towel. Apply a thin layer of Doderm Hydro RepairGel to the irritated skin 2–3 times daily. First results can be seen after 3–5 days. Continue application until the skin has fully recovered (on average 2–3 weeks).

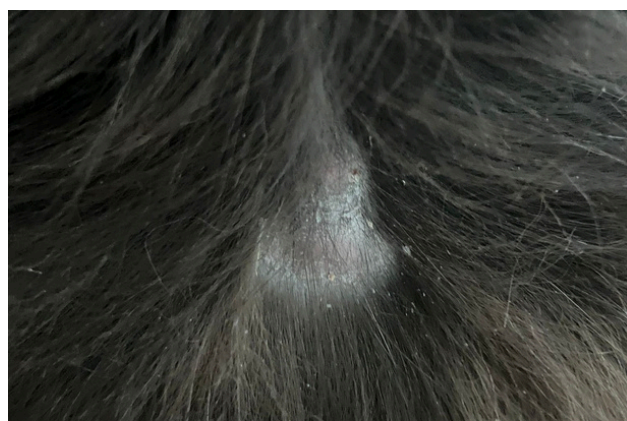
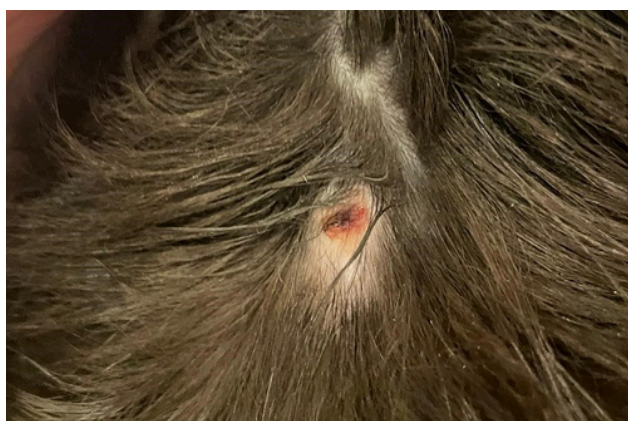


Example of Use

Beike, an 11-year-old Frisian Stabij with a thick coat, developed hotspots during a prolonged period of wet weather – moist, inflamed skin with hair loss caused by excessive licking. Her owner had previously tried honey ointment, but it was difficult to apply because of Beike's long hair. After applying Doderm Hydro RepairGel daily for one week, the skin improved significantly, the licking stopped, and new hair had already started to grow.



CJ, a 4-year-old Maine Coon, developed bald, inflamed patches after scratching at tick bites. The affected areas were treated daily with Doderm Hydro RepairGel for one week. The itching decreased significantly, CJ scratched less, and the skin began to heal visibly.
