Our PCB portfolio includes everything from 2-layer boards to highly advanced HDI and flex boards. We know that nothing affects the PCB's total cost and reliability more than its initial design. That's why all our local offices have dedicated specialists who work closely with you - from design support (DfM) and early prototyping to series production.

Meeting national compliance demands across industry sectors

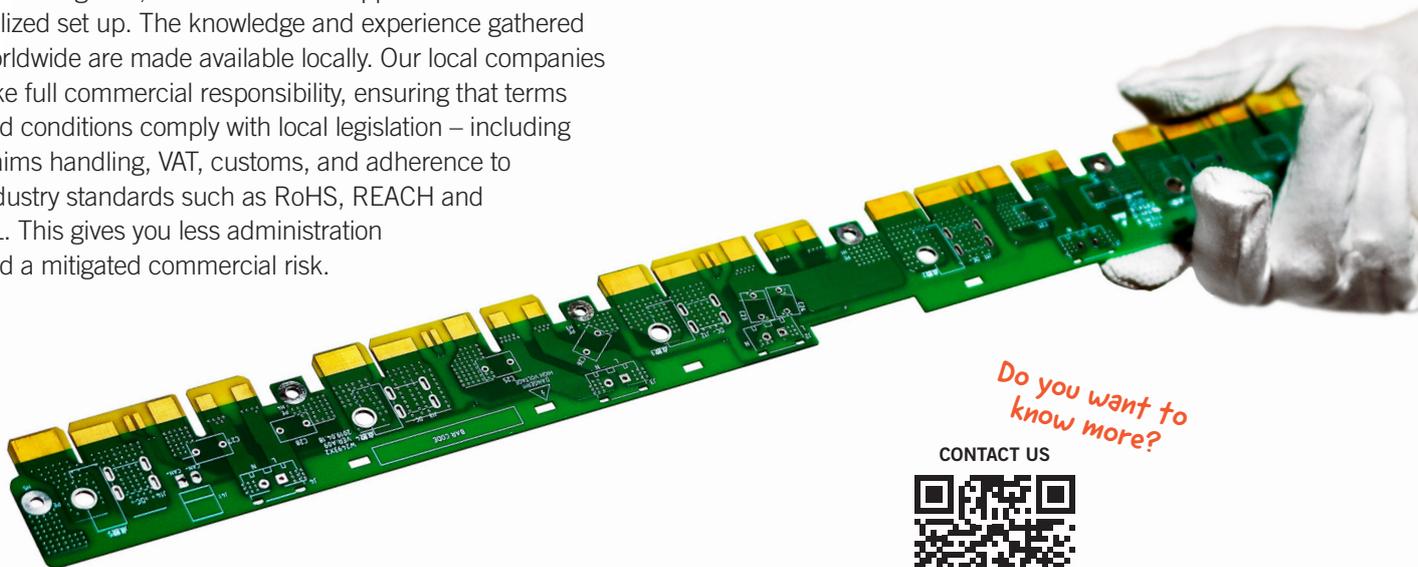
All of our factories are ISO 9001 and ISO 14001 certified. We ensure compliance with the specific standards of the industries we support, for example ITAR, EAR, FAR/DFAR(s), AS9100, EN9100, NADCAP, EN 45545-2, IATF 16949. Our solution to handle sensitive data for defense projects is built to meet the standards for NIST800-171 (cyber security).

Systematically sourced factories

Finding and developing the right factories requires a broad range of expertise. We source and approve factories based on their technological capabilities, production volumes, and the industry sectors they can reliably support. Our sourcing process is thorough and typically takes around a year – from identifying potential candidates to final factory approval.

Audits to ensure quality and sustainability

In all our main factories, full quality audits are performed annually. They are supplemented with pre-production process audits, monthly process audits, and sustainability audits. In 2024, out of 36 factories, we completed 337 audits, had 823 factory meetings and created 5,684 actions for proactive and reactive quality assurance.
