CROCUS TOMASSINIANUS RUBY GIANT



Early crocus

One of the best naturalisers for lawns. Delay mowing until the foliage has yellowed; this allows it to multiply quickly and produce fresh drifts of colour each spring.



CROCUS VERNUS FLOWER RECORD



Large-flowered crocus

Large blooms provide immediate colour impact. Works well among low ground covers, where it enjoys the light of early spring.



CROCUS VERNUS JEANNE D'ARC



Fresh white crocus

Pure white with a bright orange stigma, bringing light to early plantings. Combines beautifully with low ground covers or along paths where the first signs of spring appear.



GALANTHUS ELWESII



Robust early snowdrop

Excellent beneath shrubs. Reliable, clearly visible and well suited to large-scale naturalising.



CHIONODOXA FORBESII BLUE GIANT



Glory-of-the-snow

Ideal for naturalistic scatter planting. Apply generously through lawns or beneath shrubs to create an early blue haze before the grass really starts to grow.



SCILLA SIBERICA



Blue spring carpet

A classic beneath shrubs. Plant generously to create a blue carpet before shrubs come fully into leaf.



NARCISSUS GOLDEN HARVEST



Classic trumpet daffodil

A dependable daffodil for large planting areas. Combines well with perennials that later take over the foliage.



NARCISSUS QUAIL



Airy botanical daffodil

Several flowers per stem create a loose, natural effect. Attractive in extensive plantings and flower-rich grassland.



TULIPA CLUSIANA PEPPERMINTSTICK



Slender botanical tulip

An elegant tulip with beautiful contrast. This botanical species returns well and combines beautifully with low perennials.

Large Darwin tulip

Impressive blooms on sturdy stems. Ideal for borders and containers where bold spring colour is desired.

Pure white tulip

Stylish and architectural. Perfect for borders, entrances and large containers where a calm white base is preferred.

Botanical tulip

Each bulb produces several flowers, making it ideal for natural combinations with perennials or flower-rich grassland.

Distinctive checkered pattern

Perfect for moist conditions. Beautiful along watersides, in wadis or meadows where it gradually spreads.

English bluebell

Plant among low ground covers. In April a natural blue carpet appears before the surrounding planting closes in.

Two-tone grape hyacinth

Compact and strikingly bi-coloured. Ideal beneath shrubs or between tulips to add depth to planting schemes.

Elegant white daffodil

Light and refined in appearance. Combines beautifully with perennials and rises gracefully among low ground covers.

Late-flowering daffodil

Brings the daffodil season to a close. Combines beautifully with perennials that take over in May.



TULIPA
QUEEN OF NIGHT



Deeply coloured tulip

Ideal for creating contrast in borders. Combine with lighter tulips or perennials to add depth to planting schemes.



TULIPA SYLVESTRIS



Woodland tulip

An easy naturaliser. Plant among low ground covers or in sunny grass margins for a natural effect.



ALLIUM GLADIATOR



Tall ornamental onion

Plant among perennials that emerge later. The foliage fades naturally while the flowers float above the border.



ALLIUM NIGRUM



Green-white ornamental onion

Soft tones suit many planting schemes. Combines easily with perennials and naturalistic planting.



ALLIUM PURPLE SENSATION



Robust ornamental onion

One of the strongest alliums. Adds structure to borders and pairs effortlessly with perennials.



CAMASSIA LEICHTLINII CAERULEA



Prairie lily

Perfect for park meadows, prairie planting or borders where perennials take over later in the season.



LEUCOJUM GRAVETYE GIANT



Summer snowflake

Ideal for moist locations. A strong naturaliser for watersides, wadis and natural park plantings.



ALLIUM SPHAEROCEPHALON



Drumstick allium

Late flowering into June and July. Beautiful among ornamental grasses or prairie plantings where it rises lightly above the planting.
