

An all-steel revolver ALFA STEEL in a full service size and with an adjustable rear sight brings the qualities of a classical police revolver but with an added option of accurate individual sighting in of the weapon. This option is a reason why it also used to be the choice of many uniformed police units, despite a more sensitive rear sight mechanics. Thanks to a universal barrel length it is nowadays a choice especially for any sport shooting: with an all-steel four inch with an adjustable rear sight you will not be lost in any sports discipline.

The product line of revolvers **ALFA STEEL** is intended for the most demanding customers who expect long life and reliability from their weapon, and for whom the corresponding weight is not a disadvantage. A fair chunk of high-grade steel is the basic material providing multi-generation user values and top qualities in all calibers and various ballistic performance.

As the name suggests, the **ALFA STAINLESS** product line is made of anticorrosive steel. It will be the choice of the most demanding users who require long life, resistance to corrosion and weapon's reliability, and for whom the corresponding revolver weight is not an issue. The kilograms of high-grade steel are

the basic material for revolvers whose user value and ballistic qualities will be preserved for generations.

The **357 Magnum** cartridge was developed specifically for revolvers and came to existence in the 30s of the 20th century in the US, in a very tense situation regarding civil security. The desperate need of a high ballistic performance in a just fight of the law enforcement people against heavily armed and dangerous criminals gave birth to it. Until these days, the 357 Magnum cartridge has not been outperformed in revolvers considering its dimensions, performance and efficiency. This holds true for service and self-defense needs, but especially for sport and recreational practical shooting.

MODEL 3530

The 3" long barrel puts this model into the medium size, which brings a longer sight radius and as the sights are built in into the frame they are really durable. It is a combination of parameters with a higher hit probability and with the dimensions still suitable for conceal carry.



There are only very few 6 inch barrel self-loading 9 mm Luger pistols, so whoever seeks after a "six inch nine", the ALFA PARA revolver is going to be the best available choice for them. From the practical point of view, it is a combination of an impressive 6" revolver and the economy of operation with the most affordable pistol ammunition.

This is thanks to the fact the cartridges fit in the chambers as reliably as in self-loading pistols with a locked action.

The all-steel 9 mm Luger revolvers ALFA STEEL come in two cylinder variants and thus two different product lines: **PARA** The **ALFA PARA** line has a shortened cylinder optimized for the 9 mm Luger cartridges and also in order to reduce the overall cylinder weight. Its barrel is prolonged backward exactly of the length the cylinder is shortened; its original length matched the classical design for 357 Magnum and 38 Special cartridges. The ALFA PARA cylinder is also shortened on its back side, revealing the cartridges' heads up to where the moon clip lies. This solution allows faster loading of a clip and gives a better visual check on the cylinder loading. In shooting without moon clips it allows to conveniently extract the cartridge cases with fingers.

The ALFA STEEL 9 mm Luger revolvers of the

CLASSIC line have the original cylinder length, so they look the same as the calibers 357 Magnum and 38 Special revolvers' original design. The robust and heavy classical cylinder ensures a long-term stable position of the cylinder in the revolver frame.

The moon clips for the 9 mm Luger caliber ALFA STEEL revolvers come in the versions HARD and KOMFORT.

The moon clip HARD is rigid and very hard, ensuring the clip's resistance and holding the cartridges reliably even after e.g. it drops on the floor or when it is carried in a pocket. The tubular loader PARA LOADER can be used for easy and effortless insertion and extraction of cartridges into and from moon clips.

The moon clip KOMFORT features softening slits in the brackets holding the cartridges, making the insertion and extraction even easier. If needed, the KOMFORT moon clips can be used even without the tubular loader PARA LOADER.



Its origins lie in the final years of the 19th century when it started a career of a popular cartridge for the then small defense revolvers and even as a cartridge for more light-weight and smaller police revolver types. Its today's popularity lies especially in sport bullseye shooting, thanks to its extraordinary accuracy, mainly in the wadcutter bullet variant. It could be a choice of more sensitive shooters even today, based on its generally comfortable report.

Currently the best performing series-produced rimfire cartridge **22 Winchester Magnum Rimfire**, whose sheer report loudness dissolves any doubt. Thanks to the efficient utilization of its design capacity, it features an excellent ratio of the ballistic performance to its size and weight. Its ballistic qualities nevertheless allow making use of weapon designs originally intended for the "small-bore rifle" 22 Long Rifle caliber. This is also the case of ALFA STEEL revolvers, whose designs have the same dimensions in standard versions and vary for the 22 LR, as well as for 22 WMR calibers. At the same time, in the 22 WMR caliber they retain the same long life as in the 22 LR caliber. Compared to 22 LR, the 22 WMR caliber revolvers offer double the energy in joules and the multiple grows with longer barrels. Their low recoil make them suitable even for the most sensitive shooters.

The medium size version of the 22 LR ALFA STAINLESS revolver. Apart from its smallbore caliber, with its dimensions and design it falls into the category of defense, or even service, large-bore revolver. Ideally, it is used in economical shooting training intended as an efficient preparation for the use of a large-bore revolver.

It started with 22 Short and 22 Long cartridges but they turned out to have insufficient performance and were not accurate enough for rifles, and this even for distances and purposes of a weapon that later became known as a small-bore rifle. In 1887, still at the end of the black powder era, the **22 Long Rifle** caliber was developed in the US. To this day, it has been the most popular rimfire cartridge in the world and dominates the world consumption of ammunition for civil purposes. By increasing the performance of the original 22 Long cartridge and equipping it with a heavier bullet, a very successful and highly efficient combination of cartridge size and a lead .22 caliber bullet ballistics came to existence. The new caliber was called 22 Long Rifle.

Apart from a new name this caliber was endowed with a truly extraordinary inherited accuracy in a wide range of loading and bullet types. This is what makes it unrivalled in Olympic disciplines of sport shooting today. And thanks to its low production costs, the 22 LR is the most sought after cartridge for recreational needs, for training, but also hunting, farming and for small game and vermin control. It serves great in both long and short firearms and in many countries a farmhouse without a 22 LR weapon is unimaginable. The 22 Long Rifle cartridge created a new category of practical use for a wide range of needs and became a household name. As mentioned before, the cartridge and the weapons utilizing it are often simply called "smallbore".

If somebody really likes the genre of service revolvers but their calibers' performance is too high and their operation too costly for such a shooting flirt, the combination of the 22 LR caliber and the police "four inch" with an adjustable rear sight will surely meet their expectations. the Czech legislation.

They are sold over-the-counter to persons capable to act from the age of 18, with the obligation to register the gun accordingly. Each gas revolver with the axial muzzle gas blast is delivered with a screw-in adaptor for shooting fireworks and signal flares. Only purely "starting" models with extra-axial muzzle blast are delivered without this adaptor. Apart from many variants of grips and finishes, there is also a choice of cylinder material. The standard version features a zinc alloy cylinder, but upon request and with additional charge the ALFA revolver could be sold with a steel cylinder, providing longer life. The overall design and workmanship of ALFA gas revolvers are identical to the production of firearms and are unrivalled in their category.
