What is Disc Golf?

Disc Golf is a modern version of traditional golf - It takes less time, space and does not require expensive investments. Easy to learn, a natural and social spare-time activity. It can be played on mostly free public courses, or even in your own backyard.

Rules of disc golf?

Disc Golf is played like traditional "ball" golf, but with disc golf discs instead of balls and clubs. One point (stroke) is counted each time the disc is thrown. The goal is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible. The player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins.




DiscGolfPark Process




Drawing tourism

DiscGolfPark provides all necessary equipment, design, and installation for these convenient and fun courses!











