

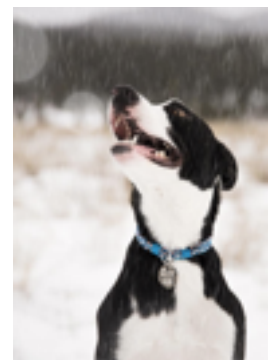
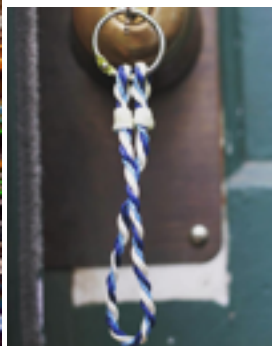
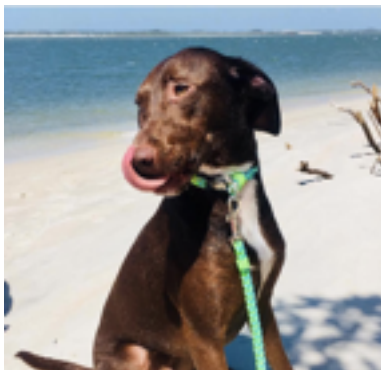


Story of Flyvines
