

Add the Tree

Add the sapling to the urn and fill with soil.

The planting of your tree in the urn follows a process similar to that used for traditional pots.






Place the urn in the ground

If you wish to keep the urn above ground,on a terrace, in the garden,indoors or elsewhere, place it **in a Planter** covered with soil.



Once the final location is chosen plant the urn **in the ground,** where the tree can reach its full size and grow over time.

Watering & Growing



After positioning the tree in the urn, regular watering is essential, taking into account the tree's specific water needs.

It is advisable to water when the soil in the urn starts to dry out, much like you would with a standard potted plant.

A water volume of 30 centiliters per watering is generally adequate.

Thanks to the properties of cork, the urn allows for the natural elimination of any excess water.

Choosing a young tree instead of a seed or sapling is a thoughtful decision. It offers you the flexibility to plant the urn in the ground wherever and whenever you choose, with the advantage that a young tree is more capable of acclimatizing and thriving in its new environment **without the risk of growth failure.**

A few weeks after planting, the tree's roots will begin to draw **their nutrients from the ashes**, which are rich in PH and necessary for their growth.

Then, within a period of 1 to 2 years, once the tree has reached a certain maturity, the roots will break through the urn to spread into the soil, and the urn, made up of 90% cork and 10% food-grade glue, **will naturally deteriorate** over the following years (6 to 10 years).
